We are extremely proud of the achievement of all our children, and proud that we are a very inclusive school. In July 2024 we had 47 pupils in Year 6, 42.6% had Special Needs and there were 7 children with Education and Health Care Plans (EHCPs) recognising that they have significant special educational needs. The average for schools in Reading and in England as a whole is 1.8% children with

EHCPs: many schools do not have a single child with an EHCP. These are all wonderful children, who enrich our school community in very many ways, but having six times the average number of children with significant special needs obviously affects our attainment. We have shown our results with the most complex children with EHCPs which is the reported result and without so you can see the difference in attainment
