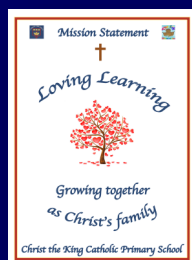

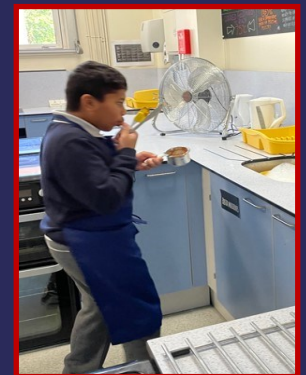

Online Viewing Alert

As part of our geography topic - our local area - all of KS1 had a walk around Whitley to see what was in their local area. The children talked about the things they could see, such as the leisure centre, the schools and the park. They were all fantastic and listened beautifully.



As part of our English unit, the children wrote and illustrated their own story books. They all worked so hard that we decided to host a “book-nic” where the children brought in their favourite toys and shared their stories (and a few biscuits). We all had a lovely afternoon!

Healthy Snacks

We have noticed an increasing number of KS2 children bringing in a variety of unhealthy snacks for break time eg. Chocolate, cookies, crisps.

When the children start at CTK School in Nursery or Reception they eat healthy snacks that are fruit or vegetables. The Government scheme is to provide all Early Years and Key Stage One Children with a piece of fruit or veg until the end of year 2. We want to continue this healthy eating in KS2. Can we ask that you provide your child with a healthy snack for their mid morning break . Examples of healthy snacks are: fruit, vegetables, rice cakes and bread sticks.

School Building Fund

Christ The King is a Voluntary Aided School. This means that our funding is slightly different from most other schools locally. In particular, it means that unlike our neighbouring schools we have to pay a set percentage of the cost of any major purchases or building work.

To enable us to do this we ask for a contribution of £10 per child, per term (based on three terms a year) The money we receive is allocated solely for our school's use and helps us to fund future projects which would otherwise not be possible.

The £10 contribution is paid via School Money and this term's contribution is now available for payment.
