

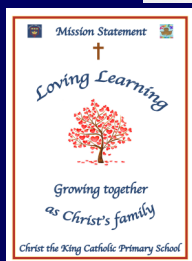

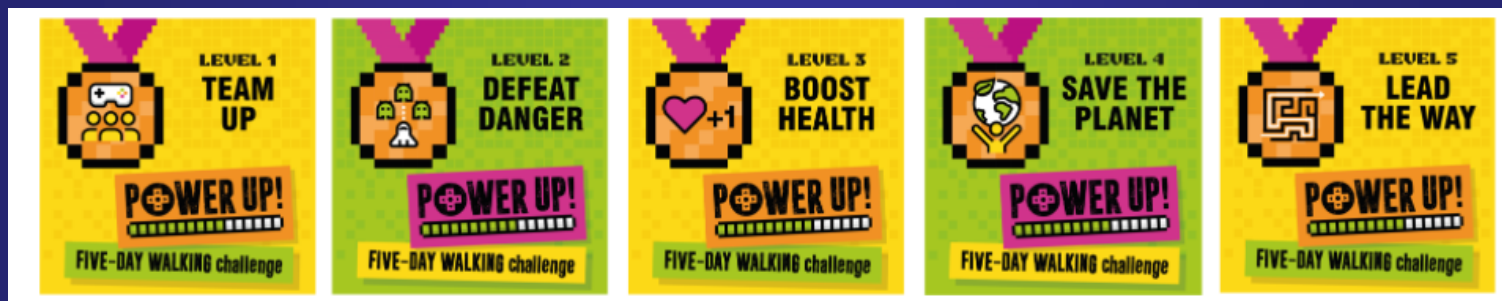

Children will be well on their way to reaching their recommended 60 minutes minimum of physical activity per day before even reaching the school gates! Not only will it set them up for a positive day in the classroom, but it will also help create healthy habits for life. The week-long event is taking place in the **week commencing 16th May** and the theme this year will be **'Power Up'!**

Are your pupils ready to **#PowerUp**? This year's challenge, **#PowerUp**, will engage pupils through video game-inspired design, encouraging them to travel sustainably to school every day of the week. Each day will see a level unlocked and a new mission to complete, through which pupils will discover the incredible benefits of walking for individuals, communities and the planet.

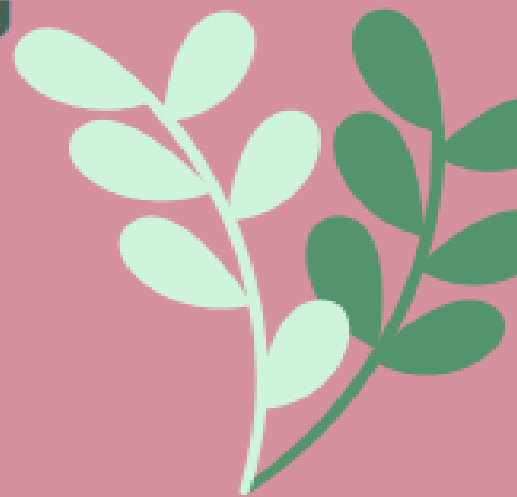
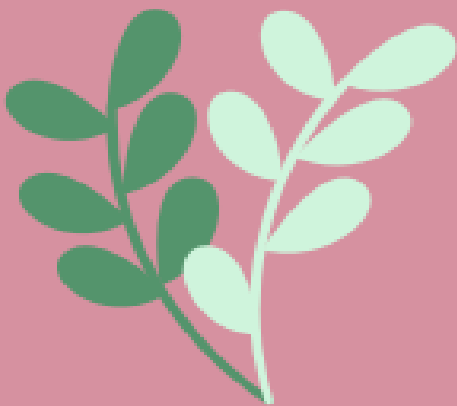
