

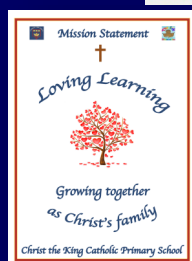

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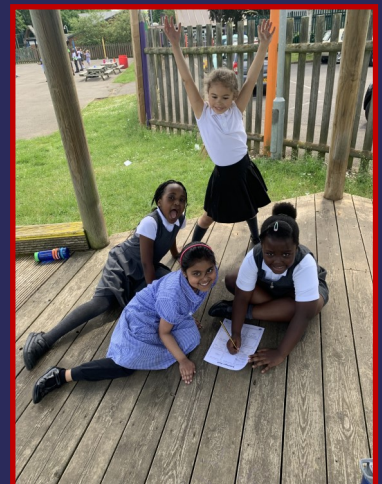


Today our House Captains celebrated Mass with other schools across the diocese at Portsmouth Cathedral. The Bishop led the mass. It was a joyous occasion.

SEND Short Breaks - Multi Sports Camps May/June half term

SEND multi sports are on this half term for children aged 8 to 16 on the following dates:

Monday 30th May, Tuesday 31st May, Wednesday 1st June @ The Avenue School, Conwy Close RG30 4BZ

Each day will run from 10:30 - 14:00 at £10 per day or £30 for the full course. During the camps the children will work with qualified staff that have experience working with children and young people with disabilities. During their time on the course the children will do the following sports: Boccia, Kurling, Basketball, football, multi sports.

Also running in partnership with Reading Rockets in order to put on Basketball sessions that will suit SEND children with exits routes to their weekly SEND sessions.
