

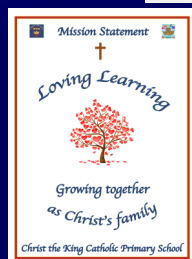

Next weekend a number of children are making their first Holy Communion at Christ the King Church.

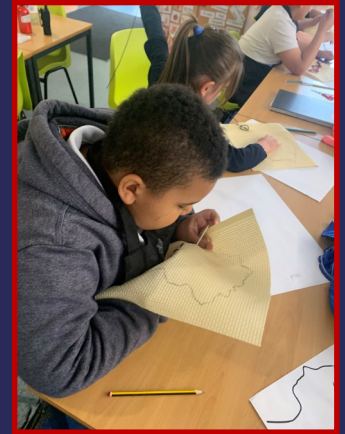
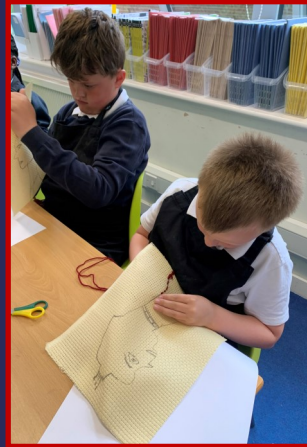
