

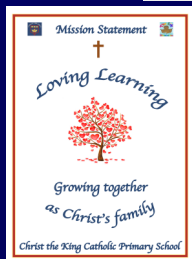
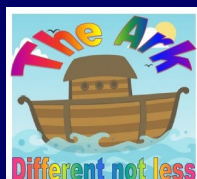

Mrs McVeigh spoke to the children during her worship about how we can use the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Ibrahim wrote this amazing piece of writing about how he thought we could all apply this.

To show Gifts of the Holy Spirit, you need to be able to understand their actual meaning. The Holy Spirit was first given to the disciples at Pentecost before Jesus ascended into Heaven, to assist them in their mission to spread the Word of God.

Suppose if you see a homeless person on the side of the road, you could spare some money since the clothes they are wearing, may be the only set they own. Well you may just think, why don't they get a job? I agree, but sometimes bad time times fall on them. So show the gift of Understanding and the fruits of love and kindness will flow as you help by giving them food to eat.

Furthermore, another essential fruit of the Holy Spirit is Self-Control, something essential in order to be a good Christian. For example, In Genesis 3: 1 – 24, the first act of self-control was when the forbidden fruit was eaten by Eve. One human who failed to display self-control and ate the fruit, thus they were shunned and God placed curses on them.

Therefore, we must as Christians use the gifts given to us at Baptism, which will then help our community; the fruits – given to us by the Holy Spirit - of love, kindness and gentleness will be there for all to see.
