

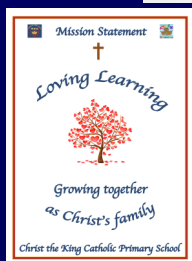

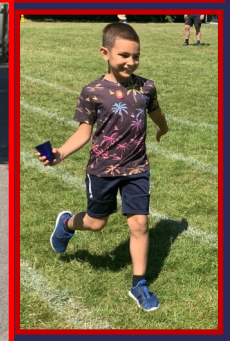


The children enjoyed a variety of races and activities.

St Bakhita 537 points

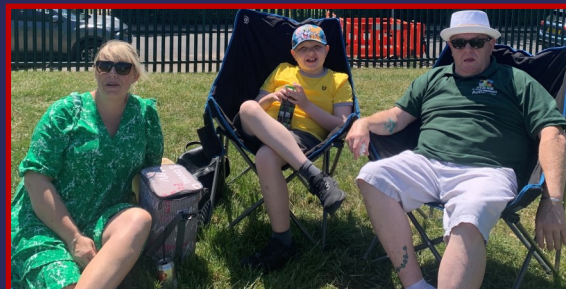
