



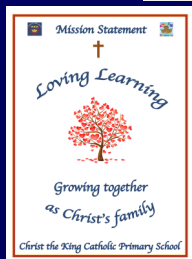

This term in Key Stage One the children have been learning about the Great Fire of London.

As part of this work, they have designed and built buildings from cardboard boxes.

Building Fund

We are a voluntary aided school which means we are funded differently from most of the other local schools. We have to pay a set percentage of all building work or major purchases.

To enable us to do this we ask parents for a donation of £10 per child per term (based on 3 terms per year). The money we receive is solely for our school's use and helps us to fund projects which would not otherwise be possible.

As we are sure you are aware the play equipment on the KS2 playground had to be removed last year as it had become unsafe.

We are really keen to replace this and install some nice new outdoor play equipment on the KS2 playground so that the children have some equipment to play on.

In addition to this we want to continue our programme of classroom refurbishment in the summer holidays.

We are really grateful to all the families who continue to support us by paying their contribution each term.

The £10 contribution is now available to pay on School Money.
