

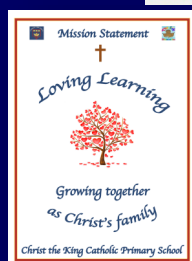

The children enjoyed a day of fun and activities. Especially popular was the opportunity for different year groups to mix and share stories, accompanied by a drink and a biscuit.



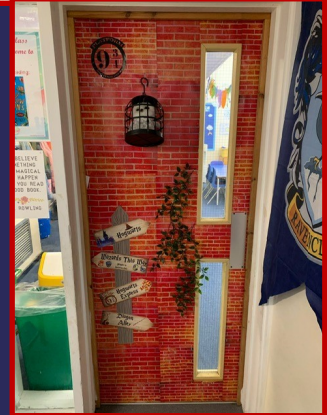


We also ran a competition for the best decorated door.
