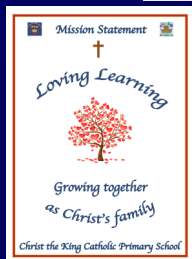

Christ the King Catholic Primary School



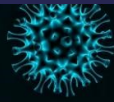
Sunday

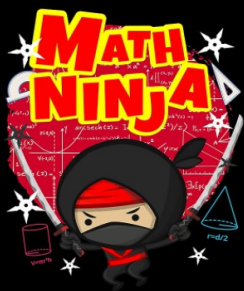

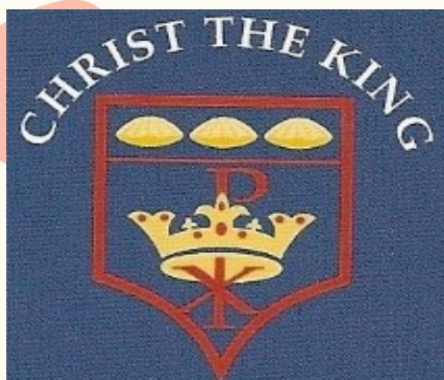
