



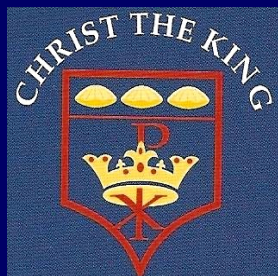

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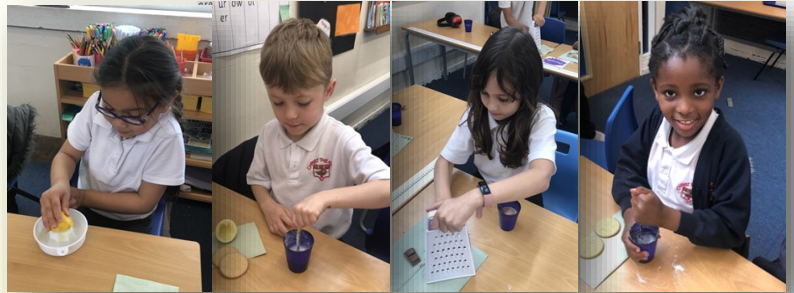
In Reception as part of Literacy class story the "Massive Carrot" they baked a carrot cake.

It was delicious!

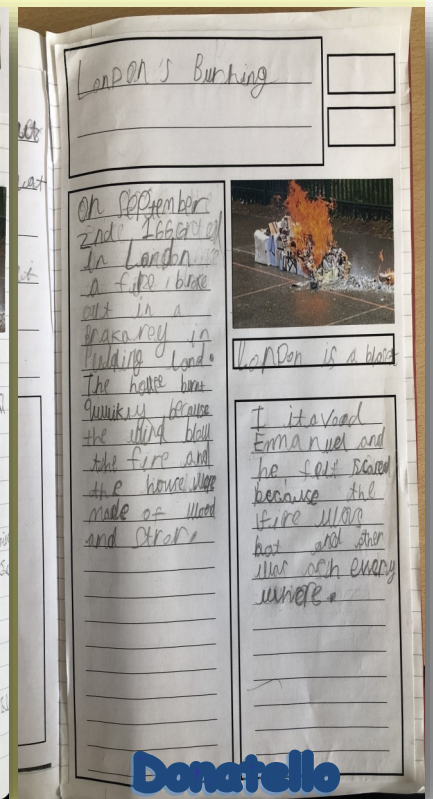
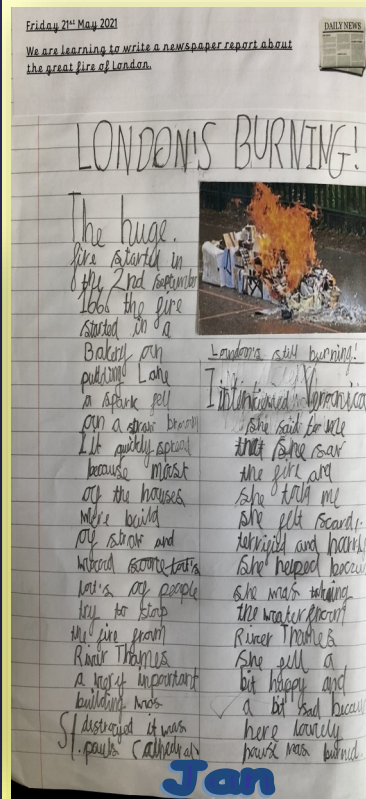

Oxwell Student Survey

Our school has signed up to take part in the 'Oxwell Student Survey', which aims to help schools to support their pupils' mental well-being, this is open for all children in Years 5 and 6. This is a completely anonymous survey, which we also took part in last year and it gave us an incredible insight into the general happiness and wellbeing of our pupils in lockdown.

Why should your child participate in this survey?

- It will help measure the wellbeing (health and happiness) of our Children and Young People.
- It will address a range of topics relevant to wellbeing, including asking questions about lifestyle and school life. Answers will enable the assessment of mental wellbeing, anxiety, vulnerability, sleep patterns, online safety, protective factors such as exercise and healthy eating and attitude to accessing mental health support.

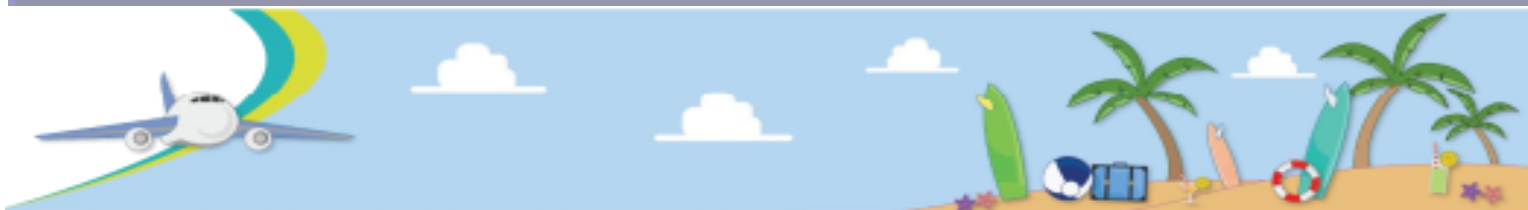

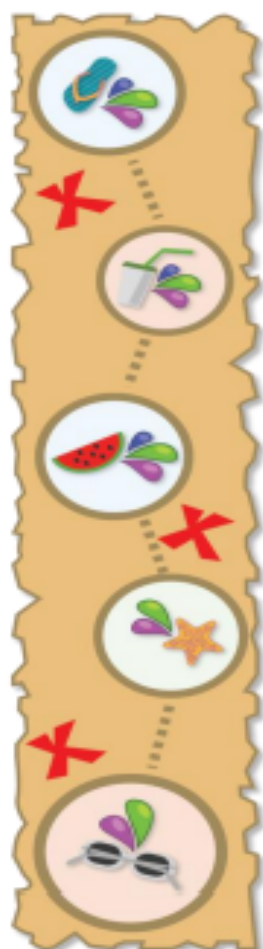
