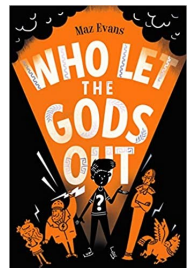
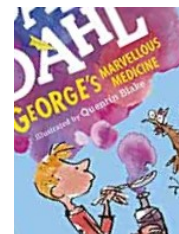
Bedtime Stories

All the people were astonished and they wondered, "What is this? With what authority he preaches! He even orders evil spirits and they obey him" Mark 1 : 21-28



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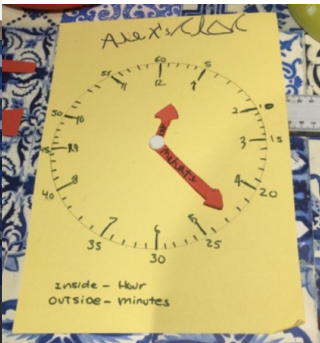
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KS1 News
