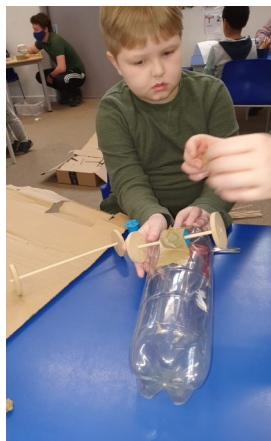


Heidi has been exploring numbers in the teens using a tens frame.
