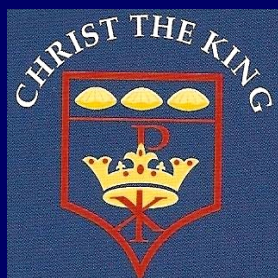

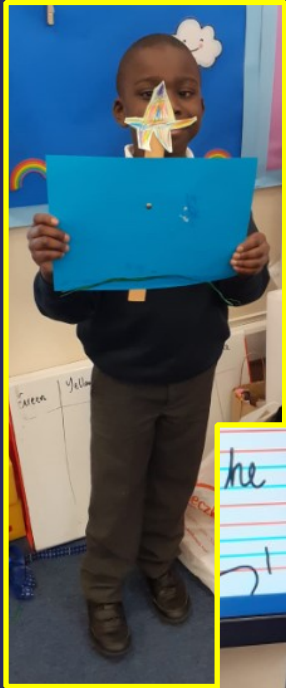


Years 3 and 4 have been studying

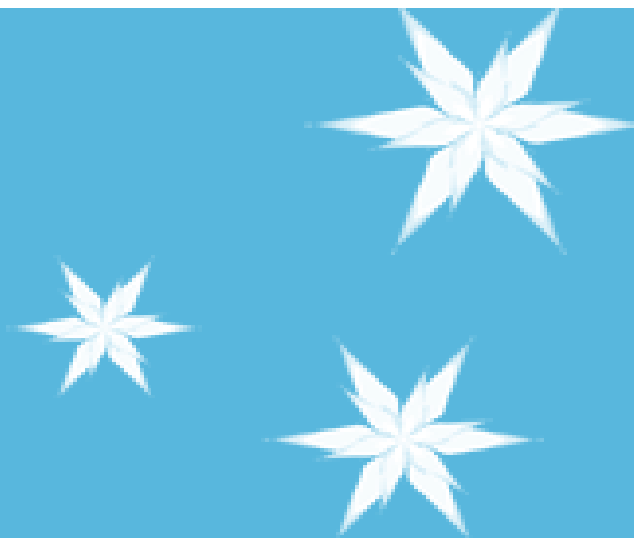
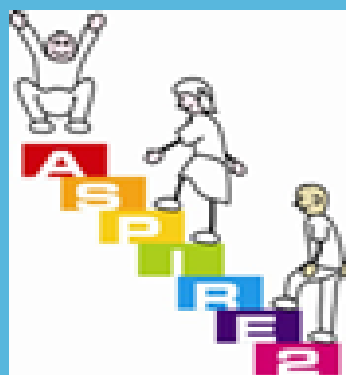

Reducing the spread of infection in your home

Do

- ✓ wash your hands with soap and water often, for at least 20 seconds
- ✓ use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- ✓ cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- ✓ put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash your hands afterwards
- ✓ clean objects and surfaces you touch often (like door handles, kettles and phones) using your regular cleaning products
- ✓ clean a shared bathroom each time you use it, for example by wiping the surfaces you have touched

- ✗ do not share towels, including hand towels and tea towels
