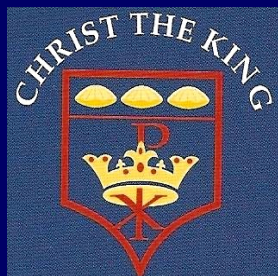

Our New Look

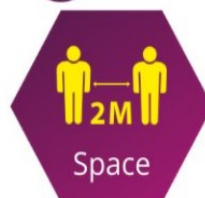
After the Half Term Break our Reception children had a nice surprise.

Parent and teacher meetings



There is still time to book your meeting with your child's class teacher.

The meetings dates are:

*11th November (4pm-7pm) Nursery through to year 6,
18th November (1.40pm-3.40pm) Nursery, Reception and Yrs1 &2,
19th November (1.40pm-3.40pm) Years 3,4,5,6*

If you are having trouble booking a slot please contact the school office.

As you are aware, we are currently limiting the people accessing our school site, in order to maintain social distancing. Due to this, we have decided to run our parent and teacher meetings virtually, using Microsoft Teams.

If you have booked a slot, through the online booking system, then your child's teacher will send you a link, using the email address you have provided to the school, on the parent contact form. This link will take you into the online meeting room, using the Microsoft Teams app. If you would like two parents to attend, on multiple devices, from alternative email addresses, then please contact your child's teacher to make them aware of this.

Before clicking the link, please ensure that you have the Teams app downloaded on your device (you may access the meeting through an internet browser if you are using a laptop or desktop computer).

When you enter the meeting room, you will need to be approved by the teacher at your booked time. You can log on to the app a few minutes before your appointment to ensure that it is working correctly. Please ensure that your name is recognisable on the app – you could rename yourself on Teams with your child's name to make it easier for the teachers. Do this in the app by clicking the three lines in the top left, click on your name and then click pencil to edit name.

Please let us know if you would like to use a different email address from any you have already provided (contact the office if unsure).

- To shop for food and essentials
- To provide care for vulnerable people, or as a volunteer
- To provide childcare
