

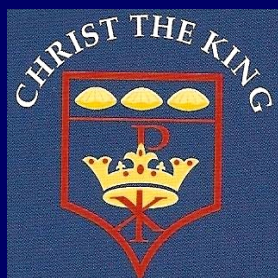

How to take off a mask



Carefully, untie the strings behind your head or stretch the ear loops



Handle only by the ear loops or ties



Fold outside corners together



Be careful not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth when removing and wash hands immediately after removing

How to wear a face mask

1



Clean your hands with hand sanitiser, or soap and water

2



Hold the mask with the coloured side away from you

3



Hold the mask by the ear loops and place a loop around each ear

4



Mold the stiff edge to the shape of your nose

5



Pull the bottom of the mask over your mouth and chin

6



Avoid touching the front of the mask

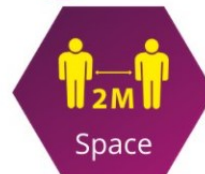
