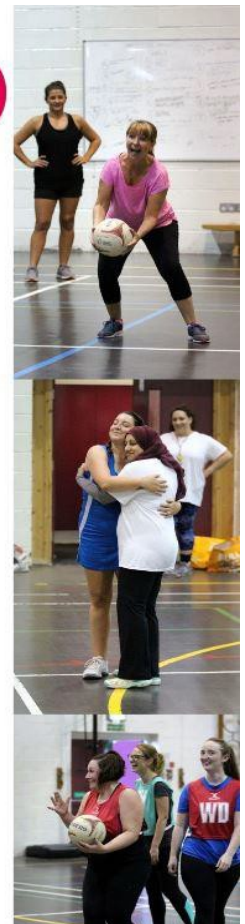

The Read Everyday Challenge

The Read Every Day challenge is back!

Years 2-6: For every book a child reads, he or she will be awarded points. 10 points for any book; 20 points for a book appropriate to the child's age. (if in doubt, teachers will be happy to advise).

Reception and Year 1: Children who are still learning to read independently can earn points from sharing a book with an adult. As these books are shorter, they will receive 5 points per book. It soon adds up!

100 points = a badge

250 points = a special bookmark

500 points = a second badge and a book of the child's choice.

750 points = a third badge and a £10 book token.

1,000 points = a certificate, a star badge and a book token awarded in a special assembly.

In order to get awarded their points, the children will have to talk to a member of staff about the book, to show that they have not only read it, but also that they have understood it.

If you have a library card from Reading, Wokingham or West Berkshire Libraries, you get bonus points.
