We at New Christ Church Primary School, are seeking consultation for the changes we will be making on our admissions policy for 2021-22. We have made the following changes:

We have removed previous admissions criteria which were related to church attendance.

These previously were:

5. Children whose parents/carers express a preference for a Church of England School, supported by evidence that a parent/carer (see Note 4) has been a regular worshipper (on at least one occasion in each of the calendar months in the year preceding the date of the application) at Christ Church, Reading (See Note 5).

6. Children whose parents/carers express a preference for a Church of England School, supported by evidence that a parent/carer has been a regular worshipper (on at least one occasion in each of the calendar months in the year preceding the date of the application) at a another Church of England Church (see Note 5).

7. Children whose parents/carers express a preference for a Church of England School, supported by evidence that a parent/carer has been a regular worshipper (on at least one occasion in each of the calendar months in the year preceding the date of the application) at any other Christian Church that is a member of Churches Together in Britain and Ireland (see Note 5).
