

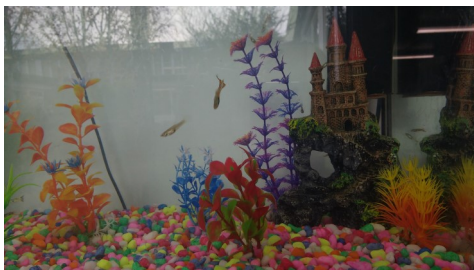
Netball tournament

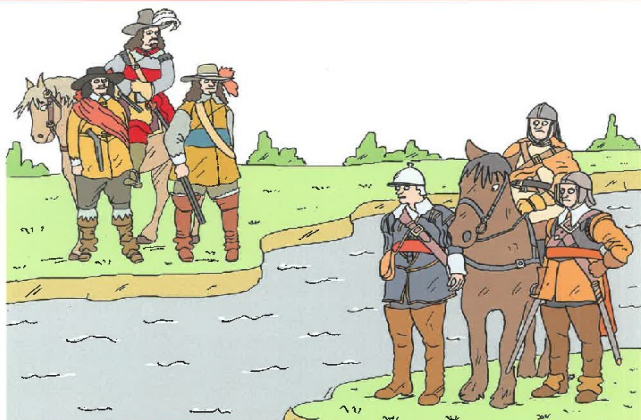

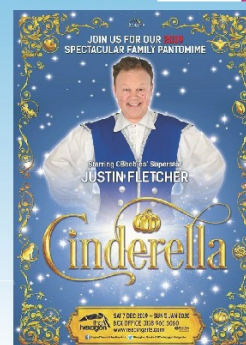
