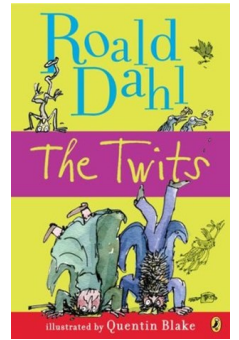


The Twits

"I like it because it is funny when they play tricks on each other. And they keep monkeys in the back garden! Everyone would enjoy this book."



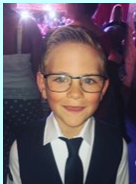
The 100 Club 2018/19: Congratulations
