Parents of afternoon Nursery children have been informed and the afternoon children are welcome to come in the morning on this occasion, if they wish.

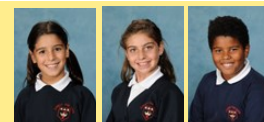
No NUTS
