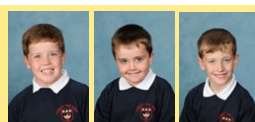

No NUTS

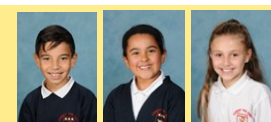
