Building Fund

As a voluntary aided (VA) school we are not funded in the same way as most others. In particular we have to find 10% of the cost of capital works: buildings, ICT systems etc. Like most other VA schools we therefore ask parents who can afford to do so to make a small contribution. Up to now we have asked for £10 per term per family. This is less than other VA schools locally and this year we have decided to fall in line with others and request £10 per child. Payment can be made through School Money. Reminders will be sent out next week. But please remember this is **voluntary**.
