2.30 to 3.30, both in the playground.

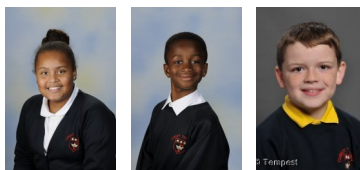
We are privileged to have so many generous parents each year; if you can help by donating cakes and/or helping out, please let Jenny Clarke or the office know by Tue. 25th Sep.
