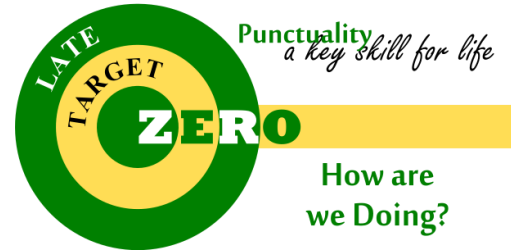

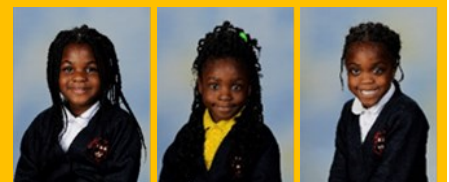


Mrs. Crockford
