Advance Notice: From September we will have only one rate for After School Club and it will no longer be possible to book a child in for the first hour at a cheaper rate. .



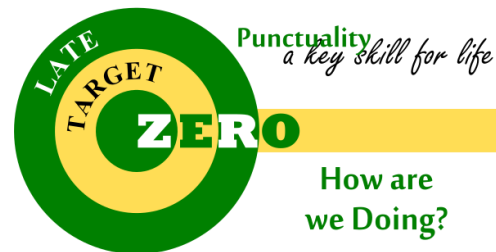
Pyjama Day
