The Northern Ballet's [child-friendly show of The Ugly Duckling](#) will be at the Hexagon on Tuesday 22nd May.



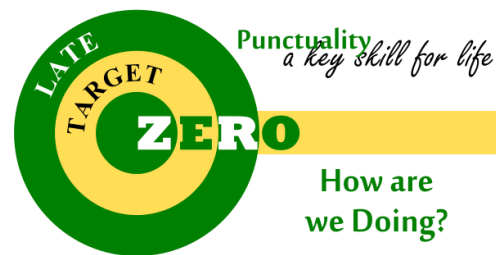
Parking
