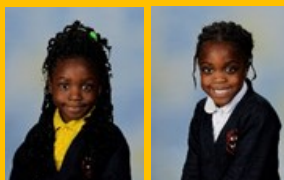
N.B. These are suggestions; if you have already made other arrangements that is fine.

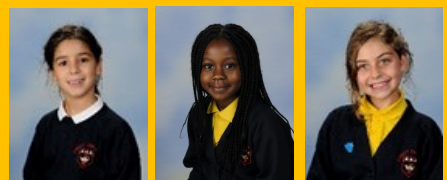
Wednesday 7th March
