Mrs Farrelly, who is back in Guy's hospital, London, for further treatment on her painful and debilitating condition which has now affected her eyes;

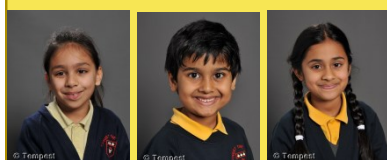
Mrs Flynn, who is receiving treatment today at the Royal Berkshire hospital;
