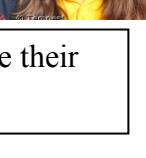
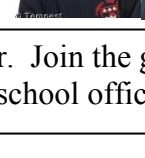
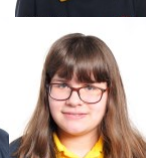
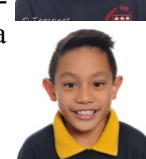
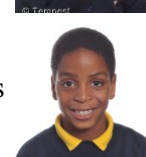
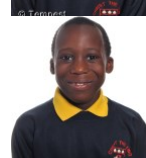
We have several children who are allergic to nuts, including some with extremely severe allergies who suffered allergic reactions in school towards the end of last term.
