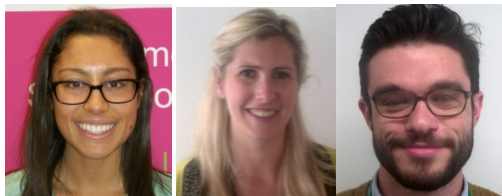

We are therefore asking, please, for everyone's co-operation. We ask parents not to send in any food or treats (such as for birthdays) unless they have checked the ingredients carefully. Packaging must be checked for:

- Not suitable for nut allergy sufferers
- This product contains nuts

Either statement indicates that the product is unsuitable for school consumption.
